BROTHERS VISIT GEORGE WASHINGTON'S BIBLE

Earlier this month, two of our Brothers, Glen A Houck, P.M. & Stephen A. Cipollone visited Ephrata Lodge No. 665 to see the Bible that George Washington used to take all his 3 Masonic degrees on, in Fredericksburg Lodge No. 4. He was Entered 11/4/1752 (at age 20), Passed 3/3/1753 & Raised 8/4/1753. The minutes from his Entering in 1752 showed he payed 2 pounds, 3 shillings, and 0 pence.

The Bible always "travels" with 3 Lodge officers or Past Masters. The cost to display it is \$2,000 (plus travel expenses for the 3) and the money goes into a restoration fund. Bro. George was the only man to be WM and President at the same time. He was asked to be WM of Alexandria Lodge No. 22 in 1789. Prior to that, Alexandria Lodge was No. 39 and was chartered under the Grand Lodge of PA. It was moved to a secret location during the civil

was moved to a secret location during the civil war. The Bible is open, in its case, to the book of Ecclesiastes, which is where it should be and supposedly was written by King Solomon.
